For the launch of the 35th winter campaign of the Restos, the PSA Foundation gives the Restos du Cœur des Yvelines the keys of two refrigerated vans.

- **The Restos du Coeur des Yvelines distribute more than 1.8 million meals and welcome more than 13,000 people a year.**
- **The Restos du Coeur des Yvelines were elected laureate of the 2019 Mobility & Inclusion call for projects from the PSA Foundation.**

"The PSA Foundation's mission is to support mobility solutions that combat the isolation, social, economic or geographic marginalization of non-mobile fragile people. The partnership with the restaurants of the heart, deploys a reverse mobility solution: the 1150 volunteers of the Restos du Coeur des Yvelines can use this refrigerated truck to bring food to the poorest people," says Karine Hillaireau, General Delegate of the PSA Foundation

"We are very pleased with this partnership with the PSA Foundation, which will allow us to renew part of our fleet of refrigerated vans for the collection of foodstuffs under optimized conditions of food safety from the supermarkets in the region. Food distribution is the main activity of Restos du Coeur at this time of year" says Emmanuel Nodé Langlois, president of the Association les Restos du Cœur des Yvelines

The Selection Committee of the PSA Foundation has decided to support les Restos du Coeur des Yvelines for their project "Sustainable food collection vans" which provides a tangible solution to the food problems of the poorest people in the department.

Les Restos du Coeur association les Relais du Cœur des Yvelines mission is to help people in need by distributing foodstuffs and helping them in their daily lives: employment insertion in particular. Thanks to its 1,200 volunteers, it helps 13,000 families in Yvelines by also welcoming young children and their parents in their "Bébés du Coeur" restaurants.

Founded by Coluche in 1985, Les Restos du coeur, an association recognized for public utility, aims to provide help and volunteer assistance to people in need.
